

VIEWS ON THE BORDER

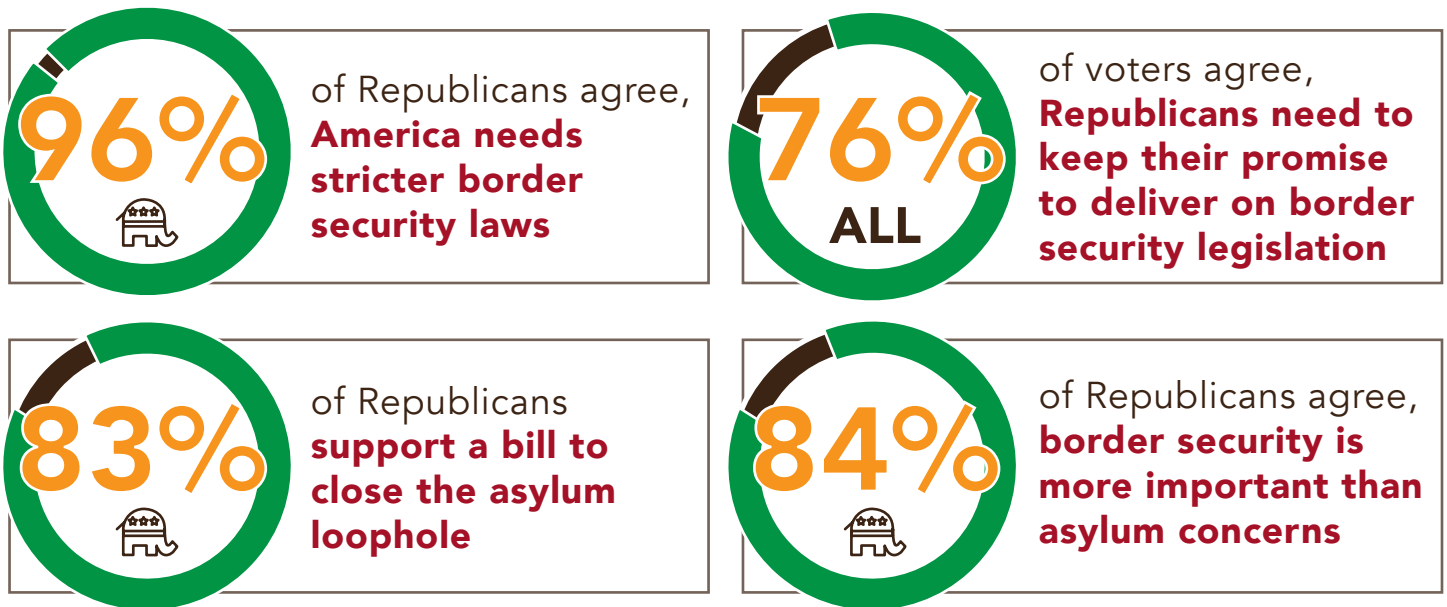
Battleground District Polling

The following survey was conducted by OnMessage Inc. on behalf of Heritage Action in 6 Congressional Districts:

- Interior Battleground Districts: NY-3, NY-11, NY-17
- Border Battleground Districts: AZ-6, TX-15, TX-23

The survey consisted of 900 likely voters (n+150 per district) surveyed over April 10-13, 2023 and was stratified to reflect historical turnout. Margin of error: +/- 3.3%.

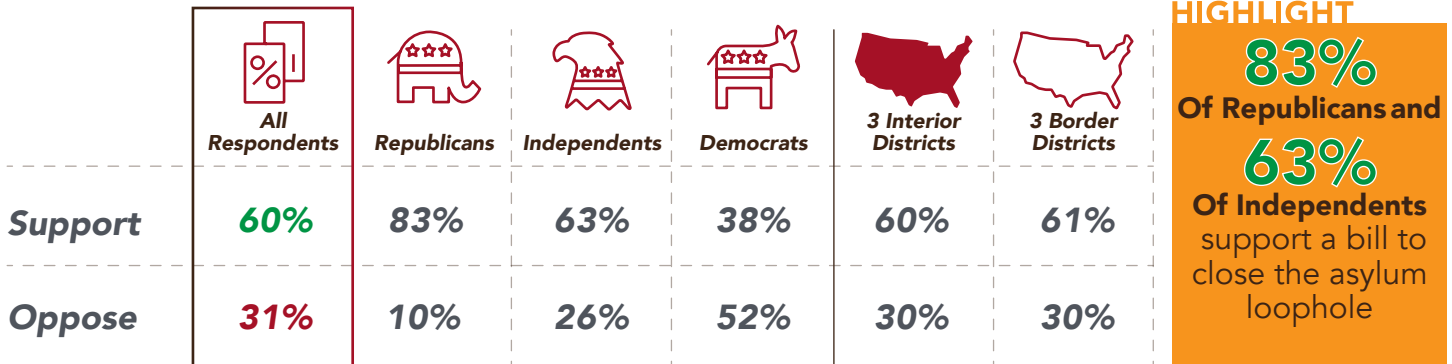
STRICTER OR LOOSER BORDER LAWS

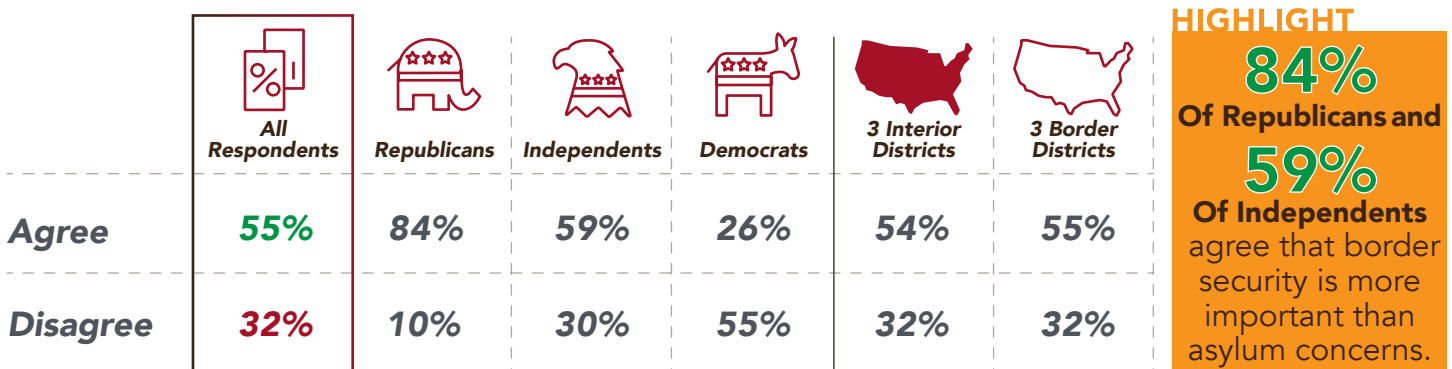
CONGRESSIONAL ACTION TO CLOSE ASYLUM LOOPHOLE

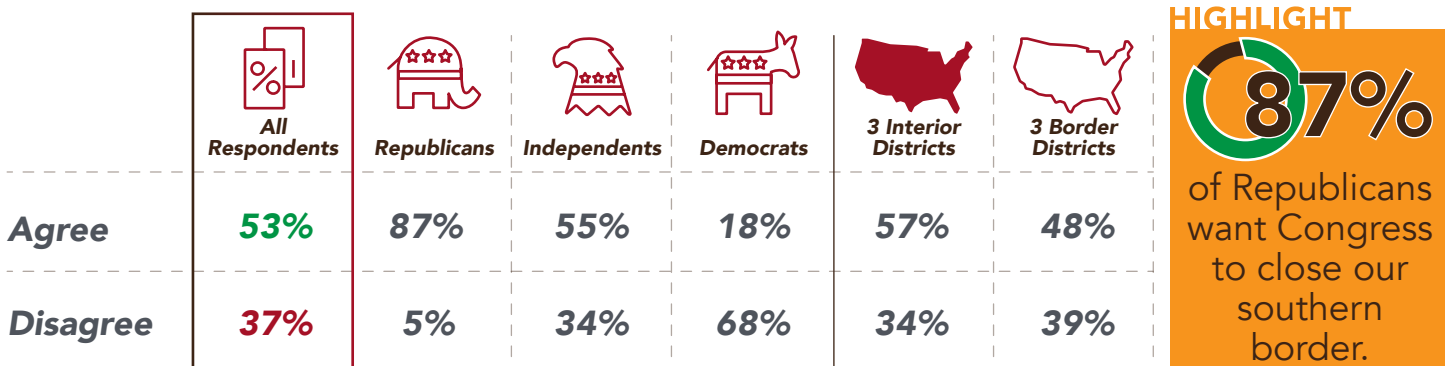
BORDER SECURITY MORE IMPORTANT THAN ASYLUM CONCERNS
