

## CONGRESSIONAL BATTLEGROUND SURVEY

June 7-10, 2021

#### SURVEY METHODOLOGY

The following battleground survey was conducted by OnMessage Inc. in 16 Congressional Battleground districts. Telephone interviews were conducted on June 7-10, 2021. This survey consists of 1200 likely general election voters and was stratified to reflect historical voter trends. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 2.82%.

To gain a better understanding of the results we separated the states into the following buckets.



They say that we are already experiencing inflation that will only increase to catastrophic levels if federal spending continues to increase.




### **E**NDLESS FRONTIER

Some people say we should impose economic sanctions on Chinese industries and levy tariffs on Chinese products until China stops using unfair trade practices and agrees to play fair.


