
SURVEY METHODOLOGY


Political Environment

If the 2022 election for U.S. Congress were held today, for whom would you vote, the Republican candidate or the Democrat candidate?






School Choice

Other people say that school choice programs only hurt public schools. They say that school choice programs take critical resources away from public schools resulting in school closures, and teachers and faculty losing their jobs.




Abortion
