The following Senate Battleground survey was conducted by OnMessage Inc. Telephone interviews were conducted on September 6-11, 2022.


This survey consists of 1900 likely voters and was stratified to reflect historical turnout. The margin of error for this survey is +/- 2.25% and is made up of the following states:






